## Training report for the Northern District ADM

The Surrey Association are, for 2025, focusing slightly more on the early method learning with more focus on doubles methods and a lesser focus on anything on higher numbers with the expectation that many people ringing beyond minor will be making use of the plethora of regular practices run by both the Northern and Southern Districts.

In addition to the regular monthly events, held on the first Saturday of each month, the plan is to utilise the occasional month which has 5 weekends and hold a training session on the last (5th) Saturday. These training events will be aimed at Steeple keeping, Listening skills, and ringing up & down and up & down in peal.

The current plan is as follows - Towers will alternate between North and South, starting at Nutfield in February;

December 6<sup>th</sup> Beyond PB Doubles (exploring PB based methods)

5<sup>th</sup> Saturday events - currently not finalised as the decision was taking during the January meeting of the Training Group;

March 29<sup>th</sup> Ringing Up & Down
May 31<sup>st</sup> Listening Skills
August 30<sup>th</sup> Steeple Keeping
November 29<sup>th</sup> Up & Down in Peal
